Jaisalmer Basin (10-12 September 2018)

Jaisalmer Basin, Rajasthan is known for its spectacular outcrops and scintillating landscapes. It presents an ideal setting to understand the subtle variations in depositional environment and its effect on sequences within Jurassic. The system transits from clastic (fluvial, tidal) to continental and has a rich assemblages of fossils and ichnofossils.

This 3 day field visit provides an ideal opportunity to learn outcrop based sequence stratigraphy.



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
